With native apps for iOS, Android, and Windows Phone, you can chat with your friends from your phone on the go, on your computer at the office, and on your tablet from the couch.

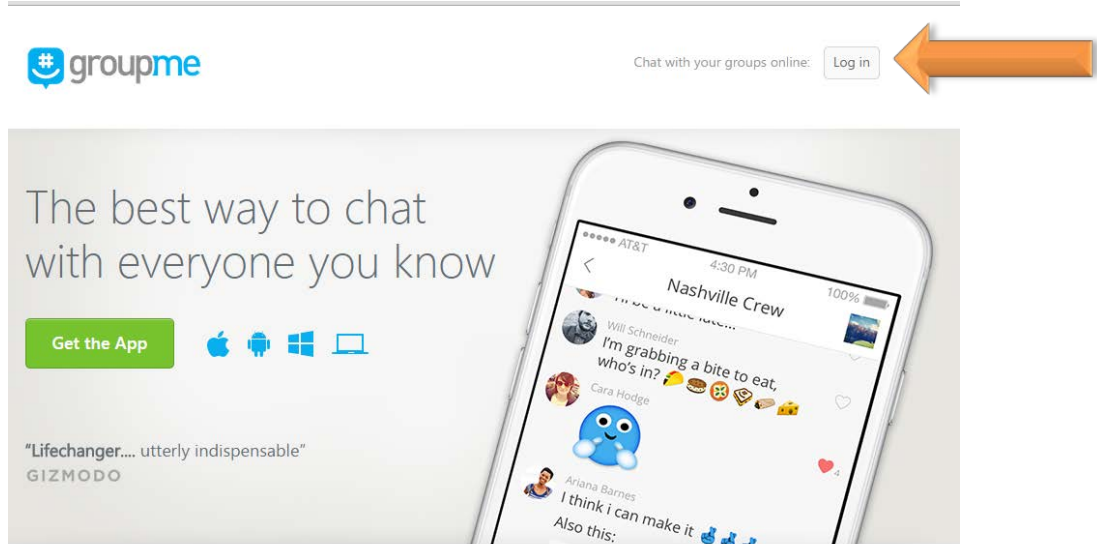
## **It even works over SMS**

You don't need to have our app to use GroupMe. Add anyone from your phone book and they will immediately be able to chat with the group. You can chat with your groups directly over SMS.

## [How to Create an Account](#)

From a computer go to [groupme.com](http://groupme.com) and select “Log in” in the upper right hand side. If you would like to install the app on your phone simply visit the “Play Store” on Android OS, or the “App Store” on iPhone.

Alternatively you can click “Get the App” and have a link sent directly to your phone.



From here you'll need to fight the urge to “Log in with Facebook” and select “**Sign up today**” in order to use your [Missouri S&T email](#). **It is important to use your student email as it may be the only one your professor has access to.** Your professor can then use that email address to send you an “Invite” or “Add” you to a group. Your professor may also post a link in Blackboard enabling you to join from there.





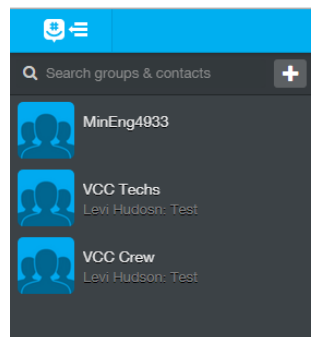
